MEETING REGISTRATION

Registration Details: This event requires pre-registration. Once you have submitted your registration, you will receive a confirmation email with a link to join the meeting sessions.

The online registration process will identify the meeting's Official Delegates for treaty tables and First Nations, who will be the only ones that have the ability to vote on draft resolutions, similar to the in-person process employed at regular First Nations Summit meetings.

Note that any treaty-related resolutions brought forward can only be voted on by treaty tables and treaty First Nations.

Persons other than Official Delegates who register for the meeting will be deemed Observers who can observe the meeting but will not vote on any resolutions presented at the meeting.

After registering, you will receive a confirmation email containing information about joining the meeting.

Note: On meeting days, the host will have participants' audio muted when entering the meeting. Only the host will be able to unmute participants on behalf of the FNS Co-Chairs if you raise your hand to ask a question.
