The online registration process will identify the meeting's Official Delegates for treaty tables and First Nations, who will be the only ones that have the ability to vote on draft resolutions, similar to the in-person process employed at regular First Nations Summit meetings. Note that any treaty-related resolutions brought forward can only be voted on by treaty tables and treaty First Nations.

Persons other than Official Delegates who register for the meeting will be deemed Observers who can observe the meeting but not be able to vote on any resolutions presented at the meeting.

Note: On meeting days, the host will have participants audio muted when entering the meeting. Only the host will be able to unmute participants on behalf of the FNS Co-Chairs if you raise your hand to ask a question.
